HOW TO REACH TORINO



By Plane

TORINO AIRPORT

Torino has its own international airport, both known as “Torino Caselle” or “Torino Sandro Pertini” (TRN), located 16 kilometers northwest of the city centre.

This airport is located at about 100 km from Torino and offers daily international and intercontinental flights

By Train

Torino is a nationally and internationally important railway junction and high-speed trains connect it to Europe and to the rest of Italy. The main railway stations are:

- ✓ Porta Nuova, Corso Vittorio Emanuele II, 53
- ✓ Porta Susa, Piazza XXVII Dicembre, 8
- ✓ Lingotto, Via Pannunzio, 1
- ✓ Stazione Dora (from/to Torino's International Airport "Sandro Pertini")

A drive towards innovation has been made by the arrival of High Speed trains:

- ✓ Frecciarossa Trains ([Trenitalia](#))
- ✓ Italo's High Speed train ([Italo](#))



By Car

Six different motorways connect Torino to other major Italian and European cities. For those coming from Aosta Valley (A5), Lombardy (A4 and A21), Liguria (A26-A21 and A6), from France (A32) or from the rest of Piedmont, every motorway converges on Turin's ring road (A55) which avoids having to cross the city centre. The main access roads to the motorway are placed at each cardinal direction of the city.

Highways connections

By coach

- ✓ Bus lines to national and international territory take place at the bus terminal in Corso Inghilterra and at the Porta Nuova and Porta Susa railway stations.
- ✓ A bus service, which links the city center with the Turin International Airport "Sandro Pertini", starts at the Porta Nuova and Porta Susa railway stations.
- ✓ Buses to the Milano Malpensa Airport get going and arrive at the bus Terminal in c.so Vittorio Emanuele II, 131 and stop also at Torino Porta Susa railway station.

Public Transportation in Turin

Buses: The local public transport service provides urban and suburban transport services in Turin. The out-of-town bus service includes 320 buses connecting to 220 towns operating in the provinces of Turin and Alessandria, Asti and Cuneo to the south.

By bus

From Caselle Airport a shuttle bus will take you to the city centre in about 45 minutes.

Sadem shuttle bus

One-way fare: € 6.50 (+0.50 € aboard).

By train

A railway line connects Torino Airport to Dora GTT Station in Torino

Departures every 30 minutes. Journey time: 19 minutes.

A network of buses links the Dora GTT Station to the city centre.

One-way fare: € 3.00

By taxi

The public taxi rank is located on the left at the exit of the Arrivals level.

Travel time: approximately 30 minutes.

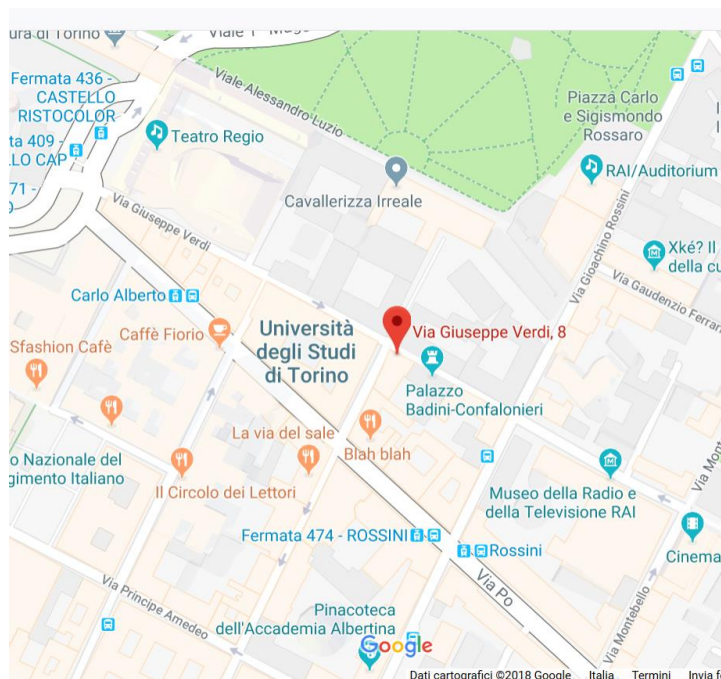
